
It's not a kings land,

Land was the rule then,


But the Lords needed workers,

And the Barons said "surely",


Just give up the absolute power,

The first limitation on the monarchy







And the rule of law was set for everybody



Thomas Jefferson like to read it,


And natural rights sounded better,
